Step 1 - Data Documents: **⚠ CSV REQUIREMENT; Only CSV files will be accepted** Populate the Excel data templates as directed in the Excel data requirements.

Step 2 - Supporting Documents: Prepare PDF copies of the completed and signed Proof of Claim Form, Proof of Authority to File, Signature Verification, and Declaration of Data Source, (e.g. "All data was extracted directly from the beneficial owner's proprietary database", or a similar declaration).

Step 3 - Claim Submission: **⚠ ONLINE FILING REQUIREMENT;** Submit all documents via the online portal: www.SolarEdgeSecuritiesLitigation.com

Step 4 - Confirmation: **⚠ CONFIRMATION REQUIREMENT;** Save a copy of the Submission Confirmation email for your records. Submissions will only be considered to have been properly submitted if the Claims Administrator issues an email indicating receipt of electronically submitted data. Do not assume your submission was accepted. If you do not receive such an email within 10 days of your submission, please email <insert email address here> to inquire about your file and confirm it was received. Column A – Beneficial Owner Name

The correct, complete, unabbreviated name of the beneficial owner(s) for each claim MUST be provided. Please do not put “FBO” or the like in front of the beneficial owner’s name.

Column B – Co-Owner Name

Name of Co-Owner (if applicable)

Column C – Representative

Representative Name, or Third-Party Entity. Only include c/o or FBO if required for Settlement Checks

Column D – Addr1

First Line of Address of the Beneficial Owner

Column E - Addr2

Second Line of Address of the Beneficial Owner

Column F - City

City for Addr1, Addr2 (DO NOT USE FOR FOREIGN ADDRESSES)

Column G – State

Two letter U.S. State Postal Code; e.g. NY (DO NOT USE FOR FOREIGN ADDRESSES)

Column H – Zip

Five digit zip code. If you are providing nine digit zip, format with hyphen; e.g. 99999-9999

Column I - Country

If foreign address, use this for country name. LEAVE BLANK IF THIS IS AN ADDRESS IN THE U.S.A., Puerto Rico, or Virgin Islands

Column J – Foreign Address Flag: Identifier for addresses not located in the U.S.A.

Y = If the address provided above is NOT a U.S.A. address

N = All other

Column K – TIN Beneficial Owner

Tax Identification Number for the Beneficial Owner. Please format NNN-NN-NNNN

Column L – Account Number

REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSACTION DATA – EXCEL TEMPLATE

Column A – Account Number: Account number where transaction occurred

Alpha and numeric characters accepted

Column B – Type of Security: Code that explains the security identifier

CS = Common Stock

Column C – CUSIP/ISIN: Security identifier of instrument traded

SEDG • 83417M104 • US83417M1045

Column D – Transaction Type: Code that represents the type of transaction

B = Starting Position • U = Ending Position • P = Purchase • S = Sale • I = Transfer In
O = Transfer Out

Column E – Trade Date: Trade Date (not Settlement Date) in date format MM/DD/YYYY

02/13/2023 for B • 01/17/2024 for U

02/13/2023 through 01/17/2024, dates inclusive, for P, S, I, and O

Column F – Quantity: Number of shares involved in transaction

Quantities for B and U should be negative for short and positive for long
Absolute values required for P, S, I, and O

Column G – Price: Price per share paid or received in USD

Absolute values required for P and S

Leave blank for B, U, I, and O

Column H – Total Amount Paid or Received: Total value of transaction in USD

Absolute values required for P and S

Leave blank for B, U, I, and O

Column I - DRIP Flag: Identifier for purchases through a dividend reinvestment plan

Y = If P was a dividend reinvestment

Leave blank = All other

Column J – Option Flag: Identifier for purchases or sales resulting from an option

Y = If P or S was the result of an option exercise/assignment

Leave blank = All other

Column K – Short Sale Flag: Identifier for short sales and covering purchases

Y = If S was transacted to create a short or P was transacted to cover a short

Leave blank = All other
