FILING PROCESS

Step 1 - Data Documents:  **CSV REQUIREMENT; Only CSV files will be accepted** Populate the Excel data templates as directed in the Excel data requirements.

Step 2 - Supporting Documents: Prepare PDF copies of the completed and signed Proof of Claim Form, Proof of Authority to File, Signature Verification, and Declaration of Data Source, (e.g. "All data was extracted directly from the beneficial owner's proprietary database", or a similar declaration).

Step 3 - Claim Submission:  **ONLINE FILING REQUIREMENT;** Submit all documents via the online portal: sunpowersecuritiessettlement.com/third-party-filer

Step 4 - Confirmation:  **CONFIRMATION REQUIREMENT;** Save a copy of the Submission Confirmation email for your records. Submissions will only be considered to have been properly submitted if the Claims Administrator issues an email indicating receipt of electronically submitted data. Do not assume your submission was accepted. If you do not receive such an email within 10 days of your submission, please email <insert email address here> to inquire about your file and confirm it was received. In the subject provide your entity name followed by "[Pending Submission Confirmation]."

Amount must be in US Dollars

Exclude taxes, commissions, and fees

Column K – Currency: Currency in which the price and total amount paid or received are being reported

USD (Column I and Column J values must be in USD)

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Column L – Exercised Assigned Expired: Fate of contract not closed by an offsetting Purchase (P), Sale (S), Transfer In (I), or Transfer Out (O) of the same contract

E = Exercised (Purchased calls and puts)

A = Assigned (Written calls and puts)

X = Expired (Any option that was not offset by a P, S, I, or O of that same option and was not Exercised or Assigned)

Column M – Date Of Exercise or Assignment: in date format MM/DD/YYYY

Only populate for contracts designated as Exercised or Assigned in Column L.

All elements of the date are required.

Do not provide month and year only.
